Dear Fishers Island Community,

The Fishers Island Waste Management District (FIWMD) Commission wishes to inform the community of a recent development regarding the composition of the Board.

Following a verbal incident on April 14, 2026 at the FIWMD Compost Station involving a District employee and a commissioner, the Commission convened to address the matter in accordance with its governing documents.

After careful deliberation, and consistent with its commitment to maintaining a professional and respectful environment for employees, commissioners, and the public alike, the Commission voted to censure Commissioner G. Murphy and to request his resignation pursuant to section 7, part b of the FIWMD Governing Documents, which he has submitted, effective April 29, 2026.

This was not a decision made lightly. The Commission sincerely recognizes and is grateful for the many contributions Commissioner Murphy made during his tenure. His dedication to the District's fiscal integrity, his efforts to professionalize operations, and his work onboarding administrative staff to best practices have had a meaningful and lasting impact on the District. Those contributions are not diminished by this outcome.

The Commission remains firmly committed to the responsible stewardship of District resources and to fostering a workplace culture that is professional, respectful, and supportive of all who serve and interact with the FIWMD.

We thank Commissioner Murphy for his service to the Fishers Island community and wish him well.
